SYNOPSIS

Isabel is an octogenarian woman who lives alone at home and hardly relates to her neighbours. She hasn't slept much the night before and the day seems longer than usual. Absorbed in her memories and daily activities, Isabel will come across a feeling that has lived within her throughout her life.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

I desired to talk about old people who live alone, abandoned in their loneliness, and neglected by an individualist society; the elderly, especially women, who usually live longer but are also more vulnerable. *Such a small world* talks about the traumas arisen from a forced uprooting during the most fragile period of life, childhood. Only by integrating the pain, from the point where it was cut short, we'll be able to finally close our life cycle. *Such a small world* is an existential reflection in the last stage of our life: who we are and where are we going. Existential questions emphasized among migratory flows due to uprooting. The story is a quick look at the migration wave from southern to northern Spain that took place in the 60's and 70's, with the Andalusia immigration emblematic train "El Sevillano", and the emotional contradictions converging during those long trips.
